A behavioural interview consists of **competency-based** questions where the candidate needs to provide **real-life** examples. The **STAR** method is a great way to answer them.



Thank-you notes: old fashioned or vital?

Thank-you notes can really be the perfect finishing touch if you use them well. Here are some **key ingredients** for a good interview follow up note:

- Mention a moment that resonated during the interview.
- Reiterate why you're interested in the role.
- Address anything you could have answered better during the interview.
- **Keep it concise**, 2-3 short paragraphs max.



Rejection... Part of the natural path when job searching

A useful exercise when receiving a rejection:

- You should congratulate yourself for getting this far in the selection process – well done!
- 2. Think about what have you **learned** during the process
- 3. Try to **reply** to the rejection received with a positive acknowledgment if not this time, maybe the next!
- 4. Most importantly, stay positive.
